The Bachelor of Fine Arts/Education is a four-year program for students intending to become secondary school teachers in either Visual Arts or both Visual Arts and Graphics & Multimedia Technology.

Students complete the Fine Arts component (96uoc) and the Education component (96uoc).

The courses that the student completes as part of their studio sequences, in the Fine Arts component, will form the 'subject content' for their chosen teaching area(s). For this reason, students must choose specific combinations of studio sequences to meet NESA accreditation requirements. <u>Please refer to the tables on page 3 & 4 for information on the appropriate studio sequences for your chosen teaching area(s).</u>

It's very important to refer to the <u>online handbook</u> for your program requirements, plus any additional notes on accreditation. The sample program on the following page shows you an example of how you might plan your enrolment.
